AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CUBA, MISSOURI, ON BEHALF OF SAID CITY, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RODNEY NEFF TO MONITOR SECURITY CAMERAS

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cuba, Missouri (City), has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to enter into an agreement with Rodney Neff to monitor security cameras.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cuba, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: The City of Cuba, Missouri, shall enter into an agreement with an agreement with Rodney Neff to monitor security cameras. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

AGREEMENT FOR MONITORING SECURITY CAMERAS

This Agreement is given and made effective as of the date shown below by and between the Rodney Neff and the City of Cuba, Missouri, a Missouri city of the fourth class ("City").

- A. The City has a number of security cameras located on city property throughout the city.
- B. The City desires to have someone monitor the cameras to make certain they are functioning correctly and to review for criminal activity.

Accordingly, in consideration of the above, and the mutual promises set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

- 1) The City shall pay Rodney Neff \$100.00 per month for daily monitoring of security cameras.
- 2) Rodney Neff's duties shall include:
 - a.) Review each camera daily (night and day vision) for the following locations:
 - i.) Hood Park
 - ii.) Mapleshade Park
 - iii.) Pool
 - iv.) Airport
 - v.) Visitor's Center
 - vi.) City Hall and Recklein
 - vii.) Mechanic Shops (2)
 - viii.) Ball Park
 - ix.) Public Works
 - b.) If any cameras are not functioning properly, notification to the following individuals must be completed via email describing the issue/problem.
 - i) Christine Nash,
 - ii) Wave Internet,
 - iii) Craig Bouse,
 - iv) Doug Shelton
 - v) Ben Scharfenberg
 - c.) Issues to be reported
 - i) Cameras off Line
 - ii) No Power/disconnected
 - iii) Camera view obscured (ie., vegetation overgrowth, new construction, nature)
 - iv) Physical Damage to camera or system
 - v) Camera not recording or not maintaining a minimum of 7 days of recordings
 - vi) Camera not recording 24/7
 - vii) Not enough lighting at night to view incidents

viii) Identified personnel not having accesses to cameras by being identified in system as "user."
