AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24 ARTICLE V SECTION 14.1 (G) OF THE CUBA CITY CODE ADDING NEW BUSINESSES AND REMOVING BUSINESSES TO THE PRETREATMENT PERMIT LIST

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Cuba Chapter 24 Article V Section 14.1(G) of the Code of the City of Cuba be amended as set out herein; and

WHEREAS, There have been changes in ownership and businesses that have moved into and out of the City of Cuba, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Cuba that the pretreatment ordinance in Chapter 24 Article V be amended as set out herein; and

Now, therefore, be it ordained, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Cuba, Missouri, as follows:

Section One: Amendment: CHAPTER 24 Article V Section 14.1(G) is hereby amended to read as follows:

G. The following SIU's are those that are to be regulated as of the date of the issuance of the pretreatment permits or earlier as determine by the Pretreatment Coordinator. The Permits Fees are annual and are payable on or before July 1 of each calendar year.

If any provision of this ordinance is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of its passage and approval and all prior ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

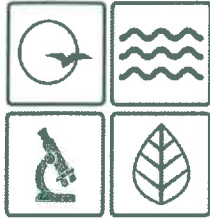

Thank you for submitting the pretreatment program modifications received on September 27, 2021. Your city is proposing an amendment in its pretreatment Ordinance No. 1193, Section 14.1 (G) to modify the list of pretreatment permitted industries that will receive annual permit fees. This is a non-substantial modification of your pretreatment program, according to the 40 CFR 403.18(b)(1). The Missouri Department of Natural Resources has no further comments. These changes do not require public notice and are hereby approved pursuant to 40 CFR 403.18 (adopted in 10 CSR 20-6.100).

The city of Cuba Board of Aldermen has not yet approved amendment to the Ordinance CHAPTER 24, Article V, Section 14.1 (G). Please send a copy of the final approval when completed.
